About this DPS

Our Decarbonisation Works DPS connects our customers to experienced contractors ready to deliver their retrofit and sustainability projects.

The DPS has been designed to help customers across a range of property types – including domestic, communal and commercial buildings. It's been divided into 3 Lots covering the individual measures, and then a final Lot for contractors able to deliver whole house retrofit projects.



Lot Breakdown

Lot 1: Insulation

Covers the design and installation of external wall insulation, loft insulation, cavity wall insulation and floor insulation for low carbon retrofit solutions.

Lot 2: Renewable heat and hot water

Covers the design, generation, installation, distribution and maintenance of renewable heat and hot water solutions.

This includes:

- ground source heat pumps
- air source heat pumps
- solar thermal installations
- smart heating systems
- district systems
- heat networks
- ancillary items.



Lot 3: Renewable power and storage

Covers the design, generation, installation, distribution and maintenance of renewable power and storage solutions.

This includes: PV panels, electric vehicle charging, battery storage, associated smart controls and ancillary items.

Lot 4: Whole house retrofit

This Lot is comprehensive and provides access to suppliers that deliver whole house retrofit projects. Contracts can cover domestic, communal and commercial buildings.



How to join

Our Decarbonisation Works DPS is hosted on our ProContract portal. The application process is shorter than a traditional framework, and suppliers can apply for the Lots and regions relevant to their business. If your first application is unsuccessful, you'll have the opportunity to review your response and reapply.

Choose which Lot(s) you'd like to apply for and which regions you work in and submit your response.



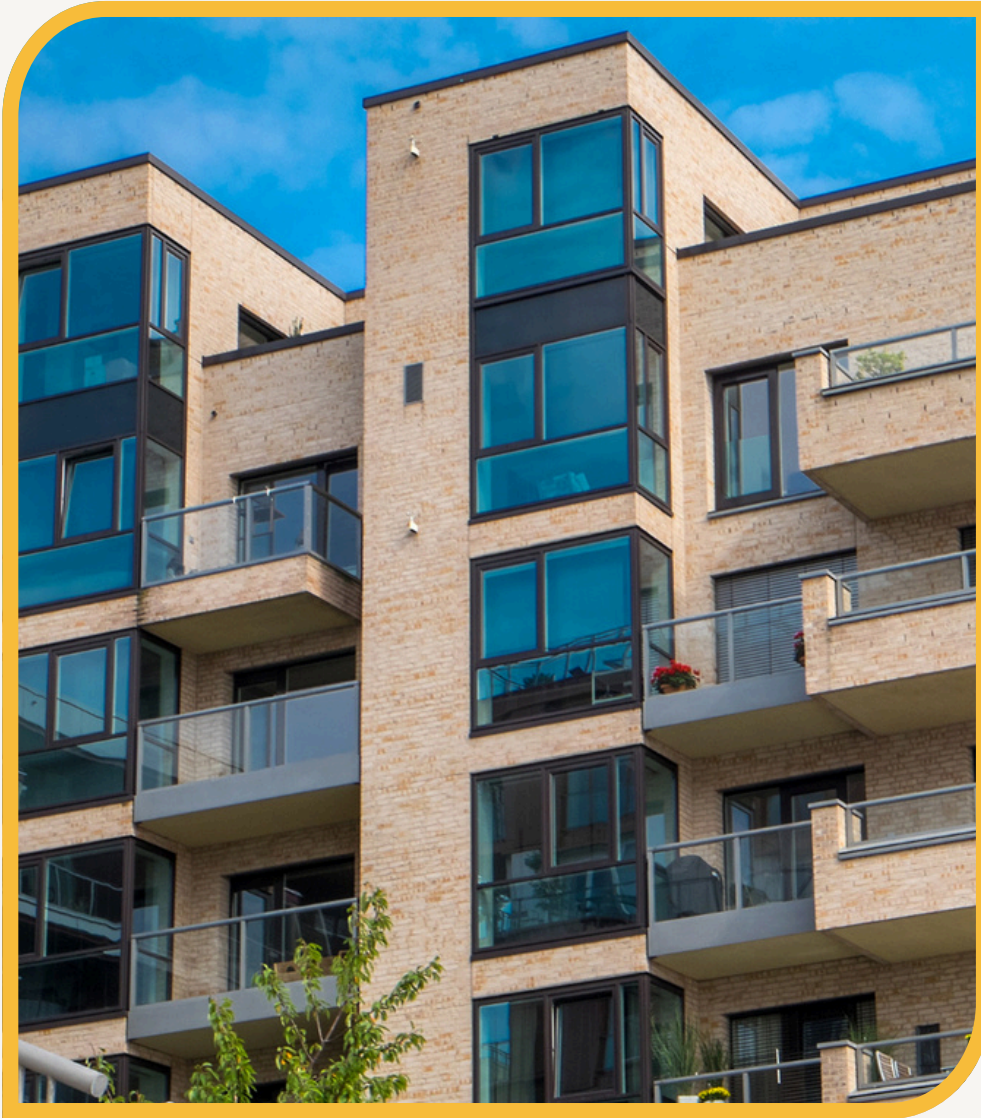
